RE: SECOND REPORT ABOUT THE 18 DONATED LAPTOPS BY LABDOO IN 2019/2020

The Baramba Girls' Secondary School administration hereby once again extends its heart felt gratitude to labdoo leadership for donating the said laptops above to Baramba girls' secondary school . The said laptops were received in two phases; phase one 16 laptops (August 2019) and phase two 02 laptops February 2020). Due to the CORONA Pandemic we were not able to write this report timely. We are very sorry for this late reporting.

The donated laptops have been used to establish an E-library for students in one of the unused classroom as reported in the preliminary report sent to you in December 2020. All 18 laptops are in a good functioning state and we have not met any technical problem since we began using them .The establishment of this Electronic library (E-library) has had the following positive impacts on students learning:

- 1.Students are now able to learn independently offline and online without the support of their subject teachers.
- 2.Students can now access so easily various up to date learning resources and articles that are not available in the traditional libraries.

3.Students' performance in both internal and external examinations has improved.

4.The establishment of this E-library has brought students closer to the digital world.

However, after establishing this library we have met the following challenges:

1.Sharing of computers by three students has continued to make instruction of students slower. For this reason the instructor has to take much time to instruct a class of 40 students.

2.Sharing of laptops makes it so difficult for the student to search and access learning resources and articles of her own choice at the right time.

2.Assesment of each individual student continues to be more difficult because the ratio of computer to student is 1:3.

We are glad , to work with you and we promise to use the donated computers according to the agreed instructions by both parties.
