- 1.Students are now able to learn independently offline and online without the support of their subject teachers.
- 2.Students can now access various up to date learning resources and articles that are not available in the traditional libraries.

However, after establishing this library we have met the following challenges:




1. One laptop is shared by three students and this has made instruction of students slower. For this reason the instructor has to take much time to instruct a class of 40 students.

2. Sharing of laptops makes it so difficult for the student to search and access learning resources and articles of her own choice at the right time.

2. Assessment of each individual student becomes more difficult because the ratio of computer to student is 1:3.

The room we are using now as an E-Library can accommodate 40 laptops for a class of 40 students. For this reason we request you if possible to think of including Baramba Girls secondary school in your future donations in order to reduce the number of students sharing one computer. We are glad that you have chosen to work with us and we promise to use the donated computers according to the instructions you gave us.
