1000 €

covers the expenses for touristic visits in Suceava County for the children: transportation, entrance tickets, a snack, a host meal.



1500 €

buys 200 pairs of winter boots for children for the cold and rainy season



1500 €

covers educational materials necessary for a year in 5 schools where the program is active (Baia 1, Baia 2, Baia 3, Bogata si Bahna Arini – a total of 200 beneficiaries)



4.000 €

covers the fuel cost for hot meal transportation and the gas cylinders for meal preparation



7.000 €

covers the expenses for 200 school uniforms (35 euro/child) Girls: shirt, dress, shoes, leggings. Boys: shirt, trousers, vest/jacket/sweater, shoes.



8.000 €

covers the acquisition of 200 completely equipped backpacks for a year (40/euro/child)



30.000 €

covers a daily hot meal for 200 schoolchildren

Tackling poverty through education



In Suceava District in the very rural and remote northeast of Romania, employment opportunities are extremely limited. To make matters worse, many families, and children in particular, are affected by alcoholism, domestic violence and family breakup. As a result many parents are unable to support their children in education; so school dropout rates, beginning at primary school level, are very high.





Each year our community-based projects reach out to over 200 disadvantaged children and their families in six villages in the rural northeast, enabling them to pursue and continue their education. This greatly improves their chances in life, promotes employment and participation in their community and offers a way out of poverty.

FARA's incentives to education are in the form of food (a daily nutritious hot meal – for most of the children this is their only meal that day), clothing, social support, and medical support (if you are unemployed in Romania you have only limited access to healthcare). We also organize after-school classes where some of the children are given extra tuition and help with their homework.
