

LABDOO GADGET DONATION TURNOVER REPORT



Labdoo has donated two (2) laptops for the use of BINHI Scholars. As per agreement with Labdoo, these laptops may be claimed by schools and projects and not by individuals. As such, these laptops will only be loaned to BINHI Scholars for the duration of the program. The following are the criteria for identifying the recipients:

- Top students with the highest improvement rate from their pre-test score to their mid-test score.
- No own gadget to use for BINHI, and/or
- Low attendance in online classes

This is a combination of addressing the need and also rewarding the student for their hard work and excellent performance during the first half of the program.

The following are the student recipients for this initial cycle:

For the succeeding cycles (starting next school year, 2022-2023), the following criteria will be used to identify the recipients:

ClassHome Kit mode: After the result of the mid-test

- No own gadget to use for BINHI
- Unable to attend online review classes
- Perfect submission of daily activity sheets
- Active parent in group chat

Face-to-face mode: Laptop will be donated to the school, for BINHI class use. Laptop will be stored in the BINHI bin and will only be used during BINHI class hours.

- Best performing site/class the prior school year
- Site/class with the lowest rate in pretest
- Afternoon BINHI class schedule (regular class schedule is in the morning). So the scholars can use the laptop for supplemental learning or educational games after the BINHI class.

Utilization of the Laptop:

ClassHome Kit mode:

- Individual scholar recipient will be identified and will be on loan for the duration of the program
- Should the identified scholar withdraw or drop out of the program, the laptop is to be returned to BINHI
- Should the laptop be damaged whether accidentally or due to mishandling, BINHI will take back the laptop and the scholar will no longer be eligible for gadget loans and the data allowance (if child is a beneficiary) for the duration of the program

Laptop is to be used for :

- Watching of instructional videos
- Submission of activity sheets
- Attendance on online review classes
- Supplemental learning

Face-to-face mode:

- Recipient is a site or class for the use of all BINHI Scholars in that class
- Laptop will be the BINHI teacher's responsibility, but not for personal use
- Laptop will be used for presentation during the facilitation of the BINHI class
- Laptop will be available for use after BINHI class:
 - Offline resources that may be of help to the student
 - Educational games students may play while waiting to be fetched
