Dear laptop receiver:

We are pleased about the possibility to support your project by IT donations for "digital participation".

However, with every IT donation you also assume a responsibility. Properly used technology is an effective way to support those who need help most. But misused technology can also harm the environment. By applying for and receiving IT donations, you automatically accept the following points:

(1) The IT donations will only be used for the purposes of your organization as described in the above application.

(1.1) If you do want to use IT donations for another purpose, you must first contact the Labdoo: contact@labdoo.org.

(1.2) Only schools or projects can apply for IT donations, not individuals.

(1.3) IT donations may only be removed from the school/project site with Labdoo's consent (e.g. teachers are not allowed to take IT donations home). If Labdoo inspectors visit the project and find that IT donations are missing, the school/project will be excluded from further IT donations by Labdoo and will NOT be able to receive any further IT donations.

(2) If there is a malfunction or malfunction with IT donations, please contact the Labdoo Team contact@labdoo.org, stating your e-mail address, the Labdoo ID (No.) of the defective IT donation and a short explanation. The following incidents must always be reported:

(2.1) In case of irreparable damage, so that the IT donation must be recycled or repaired.

(2.2) When an IT donation fails to work or whenever its status changes.

(3) Please send an email every six months with the list of IT donations and the status (working or not) to contact@labdoo.org.

(4) You will receive free IT donations from Labdoo for educational purposes only. In return, you agree that the laptops will not be used for commercial purposes. With this request, you agree not to charge a fee for the use of the computers.

(4.1) IT donations may not be sold, loaned or exchanged.

(4.2) If IT donations are not traceable, a school/project will be excluded from further IT donations and will NOT be able to receive any further IT donations.

(5) By submitting this completed application, the applicant confirms to Labdoo.org that he/she has all rights to documents submitted now or in the future and grants Labdoo.org permission to publish

them. Furthermore, the applicant confirms that he/she benefits from all children, teachers, legal guardians, legal representatives and/or those of Labdoo's IT donations whose permission to take and publish photographs has been obtained. Labdoo.org explicitly points out that submitted documents and photos will be published offline and online and therefore are also accessible to third parties. Labdoo.org uses the photos exclusively to enable presentation and traceability of the project.
