With only 3 working old type desk top Computers against a class average of 100 plus pupils translates into a pupil to computer ratio of 10 pupils to 01 Computer. In addition the computers that the school has are outdated machines many of which cannot run newer application and operating systems (OSs).

As shown in the enrolment table if the situation remains the same, it certainly means 10 pupils sharing 1 computer. This would negatively impact on the acquisition of computer skills by learner.
