Project Description Please explain about your project and how you will use the laptops (*): Rwenzori Youth Initiatives for Development (RWEYIDA) is a non government and non for profit organization that is based in Uganda which implements the projects that empowers the youth and other vulnerable groups of people in Uganda and beyond. It has been noted that during a 2 years lockdown most young girls have been impregnanted others got married early. This has been observed through our baseline survey that was conducted in Kasese Municipality in January 2022. The businesses were on stand still during lockdown and others collapsed. Therefore RWEYIDA is requesting the 4 laptops and 2 tablets to train 40 youth in ICT at their training center to improve their skills and secure their future livelihood survival. The youth will be selected in the most vulnerable households that were mostly affected due to COVID 19 pandemic. The project will aim at improving on youth skills and strengthen on their livelihood income by the end 2023. In addition the project will be centered on youth empowerment through skill development so that they can manage to demand their rights. The organization has organized this arrangement as the pilot project that will help the youth especially young girls who have produced due to the effects of COVID 19 pandemic. The project is a pilot project that has been initiated by RWEYIDA which will take six months to achieve its intended objective, it will be introduced to the whole region since the region was heavily affected by COVID 19 pandemic. In addition, on 7th September 2022, Kasese experienced landslides that left 16 people dead and many properties destroyed, therefore, this project will also help to empower more vulnerable youth from these affected households with skills for self-reliance since most families were left without any means of survival. It has been observed that when the vulnerable youth are supported with skill especially the young mothers and youth out of schools, they will be self-employed and earn a living, support their families and finally demand their rights.
