Katondo Combined School is a school in the Copperbelt province of Zambia. It is located in Bwana Mkubwa in Ndola district.

The school was built in the year 1951. The first Headteacher was Mr A Kaonde. The school is on two separate plots, the primary section and the secondary section. Initially the buildings were a prison. It was called Katondo Prison and it happened that our

first republican President Dr Kenneth Kaunda was temporarily jailed there for one year.

However due to growing population, the prison was made into a learning institution now called Katondo Combined School.

The school has 18 classrooms and one early childhood learning room. It runs from early childhood Education to grade 12. The total number of learners is 2034, 1033 girls and 1001 boys.
