(1) IT donations are intended exclusively for o.a. Application describes your organisation's objectives.

(1.1) If you wish to use IT donations for a different purpose, you must first contact Labdoo: contact@labdoo.org.

(1.2) Only schools or projects can apply for IT donations, not individuals.

(1.3) IT donations may only be removed from the school/project site with Labdoo's consent (e.g. teachers may not take IT donations home). If Labdoo inspectors visit the project and find that IT donations are missing, the school/project is excluded from further Labdoo IT donations and may NOT receive further IT donations.

(2) In case of malfunctioning IT donations, contact the Labdoo team at contact@labdoo.org, indicating your email address, the Labdoo ID number of the malfunctioning IT donation and a short message. Policy. The following incidents must always be reported:

(2.1) In the event of irreparable damage, the computer donation must be recycled or repaired.

(4.2) If computer donations cannot be found, a school/project is excluded from further computer donations and may NOT receive further computer donations.
